

Learning Centre training schedule of fees

The Queensland Centre for Mental Health Learning provides training free or charge for Queensland Health staff whose primary role is working with people experiencing mental illness*. University students undertaking placement within a public mental health service are eligible for subsidised places for training whilst on placement only.

Those who do not fall under this category are required to pay a nominal fee to attend, see table below for fee structure.

Fee structure

Course duration	Cost per person
1/2 day	\$95
1 day	\$190
2 day	\$380
3 day	\$570

Note: Course fees are to be paid at the time of enrolment via the Learning Centre BPOINT payment portal. Enrolments will not be considered confirmed until payment is received. Fees are subject to change without notice.

All eLearning courses and online resources are currently free of charge.

Refund policy

Refunds are in any event at the discretion of the Learning Centre and will only be considered where the Learning Centre is given at least two weeks' notice in writing of an inability to attend prior to the first day of training. Refunds will not be provided for those who cancel within seven days of the scheduled training.
