

Learning Centre training - Schedule of fees

The Queensland Centre for Mental Health Learning provides training to all Queensland Health staff and university students undertaking placement (@health.qld.gov.au email address is required) without charge. This also extends to Queensland Ambulance Service (QAS) staff (@ambulance.qld.gov.au email address is required).

All others, such as other government departments, private organisations and non-government organisations are required to pay a fee to access any Learning Centre training.

Where a service wishes to purchase training places in bulk or commission stand-alone facilitated training, fees will vary from the above. Administration and processing support, cost for travel, venue hire and other Educator expenses are taken into consideration and will be calculated via a quote for provision of services. These requests are subject to scheduling availability, as well as annual and EOFY exclusion times.

Refund policy

Refunds are at the discretion of the Learning Centre and may be provided only where sufficient notice is provided in writing.
