Queensland Health Victim Support Service (QHVSS)

QHVSS has offices in Brisbane, Townsville and Cairns and provides outreach throughout Queensland. QHVSS provides information and support to victims of mentally ill offenders.

The Service provides assistance to the direct victims of an offence, the parents or guardians of a young victim or a victim who has legal incapacity, family members of a victim, and other people who have been directly harmed by the offence.

- Assisting with access to entitlements, including applications for patient information orders and making statements and submissions.
- Providing counselling, court support and referrals.

- Raising awareness of the needs of victims with staff of mental health and related services.
