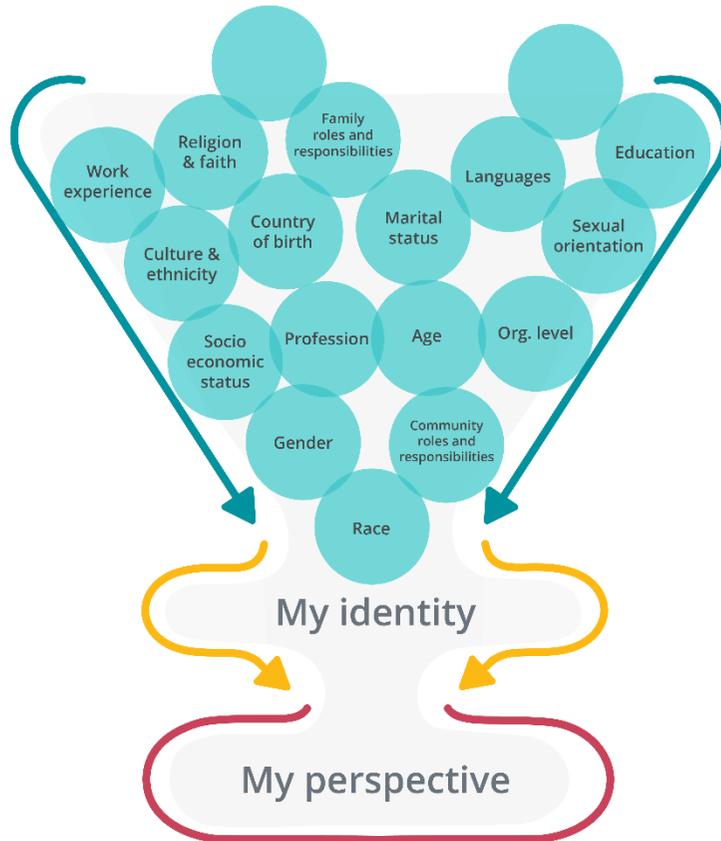


Circles of Identity - Who am I?
